CLASS 1 Best Turned Out Section A Juniors. Section B Adults

This will be judged individually between 10am and 11am. Lead reins and escorted welcomed.

CLASS 2 Walk & Trot only 10.00 am prompt

Open to SSA Members & Non- Members. This class will only include walk and trot. An individual show will be required. Only open to Novice combinations. Lead rein riders welcome

CLASS 3 * Side Saddle International Restricted Side Saddle Equitation Class

Side Saddle International Rosettes will be awarded to the 4 highest placed SSA Members. Open to riders who have never competed in a Side Saddle Association Equitation Qualifying class. A short simple show will be required (Qualifying Points for the Equitation championship classes at the National Equitation Championships are not awarded in this class.

CLASS 4 * The Side Saddle Association EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIPS OPEN QUALIFYING CLASS

Run under SSA Rules defined in the current Member's Handbook. Open to SSA Members and Non-Members. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for SSA rosettes to 3rd Adult and 3rd Junior places and SSA Championship Points. Southernden Farm offers a rosette to the highest placed Member aged under 14 on 1st January of the current year. A rosette in memory of The Late Mr R Philpot is offered to the Adult Member and Manor Grange Stud Show Centre to the Junior Member, judged to be the best turned out.

CLASS 5 * Side Saddle Concours d'Élégance

The Judge must be on the current SSA or any appropriate Judging panel but may be assisted by a Celebrity or Sponsor. The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance but detailed inspection of rider or tack is not required. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the Judge may ask groups of 3 or 4 riders to give short displays. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards. N.B. Silk hats are permitted to be worn by Adults IN THIS CLASS AT ANY TIME OF DAY. Juniors must wear hats to current Safety standards or above for this class. Adult riders not wearing such hats do so at their own risk.

CLASS 6a * Best Horse or Pony to be Ridden Side Saddle

The Judge must be on the current SSA or other appropriate Judging Panels
Open to horses and ponies 4 years old or over: conformation & manners will be taken into consideration; horses/ponies will not be stripped. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards.
The Highest placed coloured exhibit (who has not already qualified) receives a Special Rosette and qualifies for the Side Saddle Final at the CHAPS Championship Show. Open to any type of exhibit.
Riders must be 16 or over. Riders/Owners need not be a member or their exhibit registered with CHAPS at the time of qualification, but in order to compete at the Championships, the Rider/Owner must be a showing member and their horse/pony registered with CHAPS before entering the final.

CLASS 6b Best Lead Rein/Escorted Pony to be Ridden Side Saddle.

Open to horses and ponies 4 years old or over. Riders 10 or younger on (Jan 1st 2019) Riders may choose either to be led or escorted by a suitably dressed adult. The class shall be judged on the show, the manners of horse/pony and its suitability for the rider. Conformation will not be considered. Cantering will be optional in this class. Special rosette to the oldest pony.

CLASS 7* Side Saddle Riding Club Horse/Pony

Hats to current British Safety standards or above must be worn for this class.

Open to horses and ponies 4 years old or over. Riders will be required to give a short show including a small jump, maximum 61cm (2'). The height may be adjusted during the course of the class at the Judge's discretion. The class shall be judged on the show, the manners of horse/pony and its suitability for the rider. Conformation will not be considered. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards.

There will be a break before Class 8.

Competitors, families, supporters and friends will be welcomed at the SSA 8 Gazebo during this break and at any other time during the day.

CLASS 8 * Side Saddle Costume Concours d'Élégance (approx 1pm)

Three special rosettes and sash kindly sponsored by Park Lady Costumes

The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse/pony and rider, and the way of going of the horse/pony. Safe tack must be used. Detailed inspection of the rider's period costume is not required. Fancy dress is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the judge may ask small groups of 3 or 4 riders to give short displays. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Card. *Competitors should produce a brief résumé about their costumes for the Commentator.* Juniors must wear hats to current Safety Standard or above for this class. Adult riders not wearing such hats do so at their own risk.

Qualifier for the JVJ Championship to be held at Kent County Show 2019

**Clear Round Jumping.. After 1pm The Equitation Jumping course will be open for competitors to jump round before Class 9 and 10 (May be jumped astride).
£3 per round pay on gate.**

CLASS 9 Junior Equitation Jumping PYO height A,B or C **Not before 2pm**

CLASS 10 Adult Equitation Jumping PYO height B,C,D.or E

The course will be of max 6 jumps, rustic, coloured or mixture of both.

First two fences will not be max height.

- A 38 cm max height 30cm max width no fillers
- B 53 cm max height 38cm max width no fillers
- C 70 cm max height 46cm max width
- D 76 cm max height 61cm max width
- E 84cm max height 70cm max width

Hats to current British Safety standards or above must be worn for this class

ROSETTES:

Rosettes to 6th place in each class. SSA rosettes as stated in the schedule

(* indicates classes affiliated to the SSA)

RULES AND CONDITIONS

All classes to be ridden side saddle.

Judges' decisions are final.

Riders must wear suitable headgear at all times when mounted. Juniors must wear hats to current Safety standards or above in all classes. When jumping, safety hats to current safety standard must be worn.

Aprons are optional in classes 1, 2 & 6b

The organisers reserve the right to divide, amalgamate or cancel any classes, decline an entry, substitute judges, alter times or any of the published information without notice.

It shall be deemed a condition of entry that the Organisers, Landowner, and his/her agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or horses/ponies, howsoever caused.

No horses/ponies under 4yrs permitted in any class.

Upon receipt of an SAE, entry fees (less £5 per competitor to cover administration costs) will be refunded should the event be cancelled.

The organisers reserve the right to eliminate any competitor who, in their opinion, places him/herself or others in any danger or who fails to observe the rules.

All non members of SSA must fill in form and pay day membership.
